



# Bath Time



## Language Activity:

- Find lots of rubber/plastic toys which can go in the bath.
- Let the objects float and ask your child to find the \_\_\_\_\_.
- Give a running commentary of what your child is doing. For example, if they are playing with the ducks the adult will say: "duck swimming... splash...oh no...under water".
- Make up songs whilst washing: "This is the way we **wash** our **face**, wash our face, wash our face".

## Speech Activity:

- Choose a toy and label this. Talk about the sound at the beginning of the word.
- Catch some bubbles and practice blowing these.
- Listen out for noises in the bath such as the tap dripping, the water splashing, the rubber duck squeaking. Draw your child's attention to these noises. This will help develop their listening skills.
