Target group	Age and schedule	Disease
Babies born to hepatitis B infected mothers	At birth, 4 weeks and 12 months old	Hepatitis B
Infants in areas of the country with tuberculosis (TB) incidence \geq 40/100,000	Around 28 days old	Tuberculosis
Infants with a parent or grandparent born in a high incidence country	Around 28 days old	Tuberculosis
Children in a clinical risk group	From 6 months to 17 years of age	Influenza
