

Wesley Primary School Trail

A jaunt around Radcliffe, Greater Manchester


Distance 3.9 kilometers / 2.4 miles **Duration** 1 hour and 25 minutes








Wheel friendly







Step 1: Start the walk at Wesley Methodist Primary School. Parking is available on the road.

Step 2: Head up Forth Road to the left of the school.

Step 3: Bear left off Forth Road onto Salisbury Road

Step 4: There may be cars parked on the pavement and bins left on the steeet


Step 5: Continue past the playing fields

Step 6: There are overhanging branches and posts along this path. Stay central to avoid them.

Step 7: Cross via the drop kerbs just after the playing fields and continue up the street.

Step 8: After the uneven grip that lifts as you step on it (don't try it) go right up Leander Close





Step 9: Use the dropped kerb to cross over to the other side of the street and follow round

Step 16: Continue past the posts to continue to walk

Step 10: Head to the end of Leander Close / Connaught Avenue and go left and continue towards the old train bridge.

Step 11: The pavement along this walkway can be a little sloppy and there are cars parked on the pavement all the way along


Step 12: Head down the bollard guarded path and under the bridge.

Step 13: Continue along the fairly wide and even path – which locals know as the old train lines

Step 14: The path does get slightly narrower and darker as you go, which the bushes either side intruding slightly

Step 15: There are gorgeous green views to the right and if you're lucky the horses may be out





Step 17: Stay in the centre of the path to avoid a soggy bog either side

Step 18: At the bridge you can turn around and head back the way you came, or continue on and turn right to head to Bradley Fold Garden Centre

Step 19: Or head up here, with a ramp to the right, and turn right to get to the Sparkle and Clog pub
