

Radcliffe Market and Cams Lane Loop


A nice walking loop around fields, and canals with birds & horses to keep you company

Distance 2.9 kilometers / 1.8 miles **Duration** 1 hour and 40 minutes

Step 1: Starting at Radcliffe market, go right towards lidi

Step 8: Follow the pavement left passed McDonalds to get to the crossing.

Step 2: Cross the road at the tactile paving to go left.

Step 3: Continue down the nice smooth path with the fencing on the right. The bus station is on your right.

Step 4: Go left at the end of the path, mind the posts a few yards on. There's accessible toilets in Lidl to the left.

Step 5: Once at the tactile paving, cross over once safe to do so. The crossing has audio signalling but no tactile cone.

Step 6: Once crossed, head right.

Step 7: Be aware of sign posts as you head up the pavement towards McDonald's (no stopping for a McFlurry)





Step 9: Cross over the road get to the hill on the other side. The crossing has no audio or visual signalling to be careful.

Step 10: Head up the fairly steep hill over the tactile paving.heading down the left path

Step 11: Part way up the hill, go left down the hill towards the road to get back onto the pavement

Step 12: Go right at the bottom.

Step 13: Head up the pavement passed the slightly overgrown and overhanging bushes:

Step 14: Continue on past the bollards on your right and skatepark on your left onto Hutchinson Way where you'll go right onto Pendlebury Street

Step 15: Dropped kerbside

Step 16: At the dropped curb, cross over to School Street.





Step 17: Cross at the dropped curb on your right to School Street and then carry on left

Step 18: Continue down School Street

Step 19: Continue down School Street. There may be slightly overgrown bushes on your right behind fencing and some uneven paving

Step 20: Continue over the tactile pacing past Millwood School on your right


Step 21: Enter Little Lever Bolton Rainsough. Mind the bollard.

Step 22: Carry on over the Green Bridge, bridge 17A for the hardcore bridge lovers

Step 23: Follow the leafy pass. It does get a bit darker here.

Step 24: Head right at the Bolton Road and Cams Lane Primary School sign post





Step 25: Go through the barrier which has a good amount of space to maneover for most modes of transport

Step 32: There is some slightly uneven ground as you walk past the nursing home

Step 26: Carry on down the smooth, even and fairly wide path, staying centre to avoid the bushes either side

Step 27: To your right is the Nelly Allstead running; named after an Olympic Athlete in the 1940's.

Step 28: Enter onto Cams Lane past the barrier and go right. Be aware this is a road so there may be cars using it.

Step 29: Continue on Cams Lanes, being cautious of traffic.

Step 30: Continue to the end of Cams Lane to get to the main road, Bolton Road

Step 31: Bear right onto the car park outside Cams Lane Primary School





Step 33: Enter the pavement past the bollard and turn right

Step 34: Continue down the pavement on Bolton Road. The pavement does get a little narrow.

Step 35: The pavement to the right does slant downwards slightly part way down.

Step 36: Go right on George Street where the pavement becomes wider


Step 37: Cross over the path to continue on the Scotson Fold Pet Care Centre

Step 38: Bear right at the sign to continue down Scotson Fold Road, which cars do use

Step 39: The road is fairly even and wide with grass and bush either side

Step 40: Continue on around the path





Step 41: Keep going

Step 42: Go left at the end of the path

Step 43: Continue down the same path we started on

Step 44: Go past the Radcliffe Town Centre via School Street Sign


Step 45: Carry on over the bridge

Step 46: Continue down the path onto school street

Step 47: Go past the bollards

Step 48: Continue past the school using the tactile paving





Step 49: Continue past the slightly intrudin bushes on your left

Step 50: Cross at the dropped curb to get onto Pendlebury Street

Step 51: Continue down Pendlebury Street

Step 52: Go left to head down Hutchinson Way towards ASDA


Step 53: Continue down Hutchinson Way past the bollards and skatepart

Step 54: Continue down the path which does get a little narrow due to the overhanging bushes

Step 55: Go over the tactile paving and head down the path

Step 56: Head over the crossings towards the Asda and go left towards the bus station.





Step 57: Continue down Pilkington Way towards Radcliffe Market

Step 58: Cross over to Radcliffe Market

Step 59: Use the crossing at Lidl to get to the other side of the round and turn right where you've reached Radcliffe Market
