Features of a good outcome

| Specific | Is the objective precise and well-defined? |
|------------|---|
| | Is it clear? |
| | Can everyone understand it? |
| Measurable | How will the individual know when the task has been completed? What evidence is needed to confirm it? |
| | Have you stated how you will judge whether it has been completed or not? |
| Achievable | Is it within their capabilities? |
| | Are there sufficient resources available to enable this to happen? Can it all be done? |
| Realistic | Is it possible for the individual to perform the objective? |
| | How sensible is the objective in the current context? |
| | Does it fit into the overall pattern of this individual's work? |
| Timely | Is there a deadline? |
| | Is it feasible to meet this deadline? |
| | Is it appropriate to do with work now? |
| | Are there review dates? |



How to write an Outcome:

To [Action verb] + [Key Result] + or how often + by [Date]

e.g.

To complete an inset puzzle independently on at least three consecutive occasions by the review date.
