TIPS

Use different shades of the same colour

•
Spend some time arranging your colours before you stick them down

•
Keep the same colours next to each other

•
Leave small gaps between your pieces

•
Follow the order of the rainbow

•
Red - orange - yellow - green - blue - purple - pink

ACTIVITY NAME: Recycled Rainbow

YOU WILL NEED:

Some sturdy paper

Stuff from the recycling pile

Scissors

PVA glue

A stick

Some string

HOW TO -

1. Start by going through all the things in your recycling that are going to get thrown away.
2. Look for items that are all the colours of the rainbow.
3. Cut or rip small pieces of the plastics and papers you find.
4. Look around for other items that are brightly coloured too. Bottle tops are great, old pencils, shop labels?
5. Draw a line at the top of your paper at least 10cm wide. Don't stick anything to this flap. Arrange your coloured pieces on your paper and stick them down with lots of PVA glue.
6. Leave your artwork to dry (it will take at least 1 day).
7. Turn your work over so you are looking at the back. Take your stick and place it at the bottom of the flap you didn't stick anything on. Now fold the flap over the stick so it 'catches it' and stick down the paper with lots of PVA glue.
8. When it is dry, attach a piece of string to both ends of the stick so you can hang it in your window.
