Action songs



Language Activity:

- Sing favourite songs over and over again. Repetition helps your child understand the words more easily.
- Encourage your child to watch and copy your actions during the song.
- Miss out a key word/ action in a familiar song and pause expectantly e.g. "Twinkle twinkle little"

Speech Activity:

- Practice playful sounds as you sing 'Wheels on the bus' e.g. "the wipers on the bus go swish..... "the mummy on the bus go sh sh sh..."the sheep on the bus go baa baa baa"
- Use a familiar tune to practice target sounds e.g. "this is the way we pop the balloon, pop the balloon..."

Songs and Communication

- Have an object or picture to represent favourite songs e.g. a toy cow for 'Old McDonald'. Can your child point/ look to or give you the picture to request?
- Use action songs to help your child understand routines e.g. have a song you sing for tidy up time, bath time.
- Be really silly, change words, make big actions and enjoy the reactions.

Vocabulary:

Head, Shoulders, Knees and Toes Target: Different body parts

Here we go round the mulberry bush (target action words)
"this is the way we brush our teeth....."
"clap our hands", " jump so high".

Row your boat

Target different animals e.g. "if you see a lion don't forget to roar", "if you see a giraffe don't forget to laugh"
