Nursery Rhymes



Language Activity:

- Sing favourite nursery rhymes over and over again. Repetition helps your child understand the words more easily.
- Encourage your child to watch and copy your actions.
- Miss out a key word/ action in a familiar nursery rhyme and pause expectantly e.g. "Twinkle twinkle little"

Speech Activity:

- Practice playful sounds as you sing 'Wheels on the bus' e.g. "the wipers on the bus go swish..... "the mummy on the bus go sh sh sh..."the sheep on the bus go baa baa baa".
- Add emphasis on your target sounds e.g. "Humpty Dumpty sat on the wall, Humpty Dumpty had a great fall..."

Songs and Communication:

- Have an object or picture to represent favourite songs e.g. a toy cow for 'Old McDonald'. Can your child point/ look to or give you the picture to request?
- Encourage anticipation e.g. "round and round the garden like a teddy bear, one step, two steps... TICKLE under there"
- Be really silly, change words, make big actions and enjoy the reactions.
