Language Activity:

- Talk about what your child is doing using single words and short sentences.
- Give choices e.g. 'will you make a cat or a horse?'
- Encourage your child to wait for 'go' before you both roll/ splat your play dough.
- For older children give each other step by step instructions on how to make the same creations.

Speech Activity:

- Roll up balls of playdough and splat them as you practice your speech sounds.
- Make pretend stepping stones and touch each 'stone' as you say the syllables/ parts of a word e.g. apple (2 parts)
- Create objects that start with your child's target sounds.
