The Sensory Needs Team (Vision) promotes better outcomes for children and young people with a visual impairment which include educational attainment, social and emotional wellbeing and mobility and independence skills by providing a comprehensive and flexible system of support to children, families/carers, and educational providers.

What does the Sensory Needs Team (Vision) offer?

Our offer may include:

- home visits for pre-school children
- a weekly pre-school group for parents/carers and children
- support for transition into and between educational settings
- support for children in nurseries and early years settings
- support for children and young people in mainstream schools
- support for children and young people in special schools
- support for children and young people in out of borough schools
- support to families, teachers, and support staff
- advice and training for professionals
- joint assessments with orthoptists
- modification and preparation of specialist resources
- provision of specialist equipment
- habitation and independence training
- environmental audits
- social activities
